We are honored to have Bill LuMaye, WPTF afternoon anchor, as our March 15 speaker. Bill grew up in Green Bay, Wisconsin. His radio career began in 1980 in his home-town and has rewarded him in many ways. Bill's calling has brought him awards like a Grammy and National Clio, but his real passion is talk radio. Bill was the first radio host to be embedded with our troops in Iraq. He broadcast the week before Christmas with the men and women of the 432nd Civil Affairs Unit.  Board of Education -- Districts 3, 4, 5, 6 & 8
 Raleigh City Councilmen Philip Isley (District E) and Tommy Craven (District A) will both be running for re-election. The mayor of Raleigh needs a Republican challenge! Cary Mayor Ernie McAlister will be running for re-election and there are three Cary council seats which need Republicans on the ballot. Board of Education members Carol Parker (District 3) and Ron

Margiotta (District 8) will both be running for re-election.

November 6

Municipal Elections, with runoffs (if needed) for any of above

Many municipal seats will be contested this fall. Notable incumbents who need our help in their reelections include Mayor of Apex Keith Weatherly, Apex Councilman Bryan Gossage and Garner Alderman Phil Matthews.
