## SCHEDULE:

9:30 am: Enter the Legislative Building (LB) through either the entrance on Jones St. (used by school groups) or via the bridge from Halifax Mall (off Salisbury St.). Go through Security and take the elevator to the 3rd floor Auditorium.

10:00 am: Meet and Greet with Republican Legislators in the LB Auditorium.

11:45 am: Leave the LB and exit out the Halifax Mall entrance to the Department of Public Instruction (DPI). Meet with Superintendent Catherine Truitt for lunch.

1:15 pm: Leave DPI and go to the Legislative Office Building (LOB) outdoor staircase where we will assemble for our classic official group photo in a sea of RED!

1:30 pm: Walk 3 blocks to the Court of Appeals, entrance in middle of the block.

2:00 – 3:00 pm: Meet Judge Donna Stroud at the NC Court of Appeals. Day ends.

**Transportation/Parking:** Carpooling is best. Parking is paid (cash and credit card). The best lot is Visitor's lot #1 on the corner of Jones and Wilmington Sts. Jones St. is one-way, so cross Wilmington St. and turn right into the parking lot.

## Directions to the LB from parking lot #1:

To enter LB from Jones St., the entrance is in the middle of the block.

To enter LB from Halifax Mall, walk north one block on Wilmington St. between the Legislative Building and the N.C. Archives. Turn left on Lane St., and walk next to the DPI building along Halifax Mall. Cross the bridge to the LB and go through security.

- Legislative Building (LB), 16 W. Jones St. (also entrance off Halifax Mall).
- Legislative Office Building (LOB) Stairs are off Halifax Mall.
- Department of Public Instruction (DPI), 301 N. Wilmington St., First floor.
- NC Court of Appeals, 1 W. Morgan St. (3-block walk from LOB, just past Capitol).

## Security will check your bags, so no weapons or pepper spray.

Allow enough time to go through security at each building.
